## **Trail Updates**

Rick Talamo is the new trail coordinator and he will be reaching out for help in scouting the trails as opening day approaches. Also, feel free to call Rick (or, any officer) to report unsafe conditions along the network.

#### Hannibal:

The club recently attended a Village Board meeting and made formal request for ingress/egress to the Village of Hannibal. The Board is in the process of researching the idea and more should be known over the next couple of months. In the meantime, riding in the Village continues to be illegal and following the rules will be important if the club hopes to gain access.

#### Cato:

The club recently made a similar request of the Village of Cato, allowing us a trailhead stop now that TC's is gone. Similar to Hannibal, the Village Board is researching the idea. Again, PLEASE do not ride off the Cayuga County Trail in Cato to any destination at this time, as doing so is unlawful.

We will let members know the status of each request as soon as more is known. Showing respect by staying out of town will be important, as will our behavior in Fair Haven. Both Villages plan to discuss the pros & cons with the Mayor of Fair Haven before making a decision!
